











How Can I Use My SNAP Benefits for Grocery Pick-Up or Delivery?

Curbside pick-up using EBT

- Walmart allows this
 - Call and ask ahead of time to make sure.
- o Call and check if retailers can swipe EBT cards at curbside pick-up.
 - We have heard that this is not available in many stores but keep asking!

Authorize someone else to use your EBT card/benefits

- o Authorization rules vary by county. Call your county human services office.
 - In Denver, people can call 720.944.4DHS to set up those permissions.

RTD is offering grocery delivery to Access-a-Ride customers

o This likely is not an option for EBT customers, unfortunately.

Colorado does not currently offer the use of EBT for delivered groceries.

- According to a 9News article, "Colorado" has reached out to ask to be part of the USDA pilot program which allows the use of EBT for delivered groceries.
 - No response as to if or when this might occur.
 - Contact your federal legislator if this is an issue for you.
