### **Access Team Attorney**

Disability Law Colorado has an immediate opening for an entry-level attorney (0-5 years experience) on its Access Team. The attorney will advocate for individuals with disabilities who experienced discrimination in employment, housing, secondary education and public accommodations, including issues involving service and assistance animals. This will involve individual client representation, as well as investigative, legislative and systemic work, including public outreach. Position will include work with the Colorado Department of Vocational Rehabilitation through the Client Assistance Program to resolve client complaints.

Law Degree from an accredited law school and a current Colorado license to practice law are required for immediate placement. Law Graduates awaiting bar passage results will be considered, but any job offer will be contingent upon bar passage. Experience in advocacy working with people with disabilities is preferred. Ability to work independently and perform computer-based legal research is required.
