Two-year grant

Disability Law Colorado has an immediate opening for a Housing Rights Advocate on its Access Team. *The Housing Advocate position is funded with a grant for two years*. The advocate will assess housing needs and provide training and education to individuals with disabilities and stakeholders on the rights and responsibilities in housing, with a focus on rural areas of Colorado. To do this, the advocate will need to become well-versed in housing rights laws as applied to people with disabilities, build relationships with relevant stakeholders in the identified communities and provide advocacy and education, based on findings of needs.

High School diploma required, Bachelor's Degree preferred. A minimum of three years' experience in advocacy or providing services for people with disabilities required. Ability to present to large and small groups of people required. Ability to work independently and in a team is required. Knowledge of Microsoft Windows software, including Word and PowerPoint. Ability to research on internet and access email required. Must possess a valid driver's license and be able to regularly travel throughout Colorado. It is anticipated that this position will be based in Denver, but we are accepting applications from all over Colorado as a different arrangement may be possible.

Please submit resume and cover letter outlining your interest and experience for this position. The closing date is February 7, 2020. The starting salary range is \$42,000 - \$50,000, depending on experience.
