After 41 years as Disability Law Colorado's Executive Director, Mary Anne Harvey retired at the end of last year. Rarely does an organization have such long-tenured executive leadership, and Mary Anne was the primary architect who envisioned and built what we know today as Disability Law Colorado.

About Disability Law Colorado

Established in 1976, Disability Law Colorado's mission is to protect and promote the rights of people with disabilities and older people throughout the state through direct legal representation, advocacy, education and legislative analysis. Disability Law Colorado is committed to increasing opportunities for adults and children with disabilities to live, work and attend school in the community, enjoying independent and productive lives. We also protect the right of people in institutions to be treated with dignity and respect.

In 1977, Governor Lamm designated Disability Law Colorado as the state's Protection and Advocacy (P&A) System which has authority under federal law to investigate allegations of abuse and neglect of individuals with disabilities. Since 1976, the organization has provided direct legal representation to more than 28,000 Coloradans with disabilities and touched the lives of at least 350,000 through technical assistance, educational programs and publications.

Since 1988, Disability Law Colorado has served as the host agency for the Colorado State Long-Term Care Ombudsman and Legal Assistance Developer programs. In 2016, the Colorado State PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly) Ombudsman program was added to the Older American Act programs. These programs are administered by Disability Law Colorado under a contract with the Colorado Department of Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services. They operate in conjunction with the 16 Area Agencies on Aging (AAA) to coordinate services statewide, promoting and protecting the rights of Colorado's older adults and improving their quality of life.
